Inspiration Kit Pattern



Fold 6 ft piece of 14 gauge tinned wire (452014) in half, twist it (see NOTE below), then solder to border. Solder ring at top (for hanging) at same time.

Materials (included in kit)

452014 – Pre-Tinned Wire, 14 gauge (6 ft) for Border

452018 – Pre-Tinned Wire, 18 gauge (4 in) for “Fishing Line”

Ring for Hanging

Fishing Lure

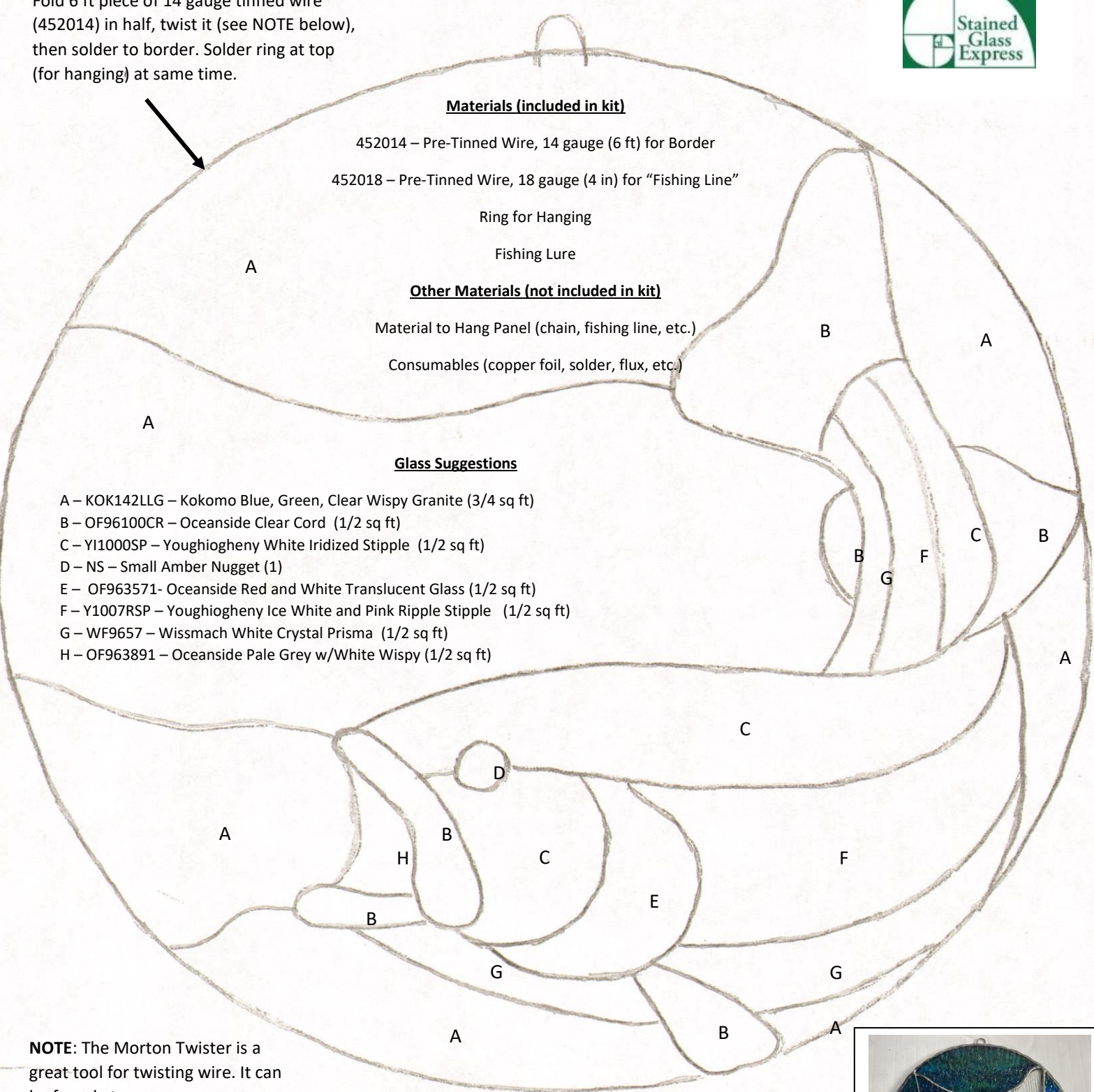
Other Materials (not included in kit)

Material to Hang Panel (chain, fishing line, etc.)

Consumables (copper foil, solder, flux, etc.)

Glass Suggestions

- A – KOK142LLG – Kokomo Blue, Green, Clear Wispy Granite (3/4 sq ft)
- B – OF96100CR – Oceanside Clear Cord (1/2 sq ft)
- C – YI1000SP – Youghiogheny White Iridized Stipple (1/2 sq ft)
- D – NS – Small Amber Nugget (1)
- E – OF963571- Oceanside Red and White Translucent Glass (1/2 sq ft)
- F – Y1007RSP – Youghiogheny Ice White and Pink Ripple Stipple (1/2 sq ft)
- G – WF9657 – Wissmach White Crystal Prisma (1/2 sq ft)
- H – OF963891 – Oceanside Pale Grey w/White Wispy (1/2 sq ft)

Use the 4” piece of 18 gauge tinned wire (452018) to make the “fishing line” seen in the image to the right. Run wire through the two holes at each end of the lure. Use image for placement of wire/hook.
